There are **two simultaneous application processes** – one with PA CareerLink[®], and one with me as the training provider.

1 APPLY THROUGH PA CAREERLINK[®]:

- Priority is given to Philadelphia residents
- If you are a Philadelphia resident, you must call 833-750-JOBS (5627) and say you are interested in this training program; see attached sheet for instructions
- If you are not a Philadelphia resident and you are accepted to this program, contact your local PA CareerLink[®] office (pacareerlink.pa.gov) to request help with transportation
